SUBJECT: Shoulder Sleeve Insignia for the 2d Transportation Command

1. A shoulder sleeve insignia for the 2d Transportation Command is authorized. It is described as follows:

DESCRIPTION

On a shield divided diagonally from upper left to lower right by a wavy partition line golden yellow and brick red within a 1/8 inch golden yellow border 2 5/8 inches in height and 2 1/4 inches in width overall, two annulets each with two spokes formed by a horizontal reversed curve, the colors counter-changed.

SYMBOLISM

Brick red and golden yellow are for the Transportation Corps. The wavy partition line refers to the Command's operation of water terminals and "over-the-shore" sites. The annulets stand for wheels, symbol of transportation. They are two in number in reference to the organization's numerical designation. The two curved spaces between the curved spokes simulate a taeguk in allusion to the Command's activation in 1960 in Korea and present service in that country.

2. The shoulder sleeve insignia will be worn as prescribed in AR 670-5.
3. This authorization letter will become a permanent file of the organization in accordance with File No. 206-06, Organizational history files, AR 345-210.

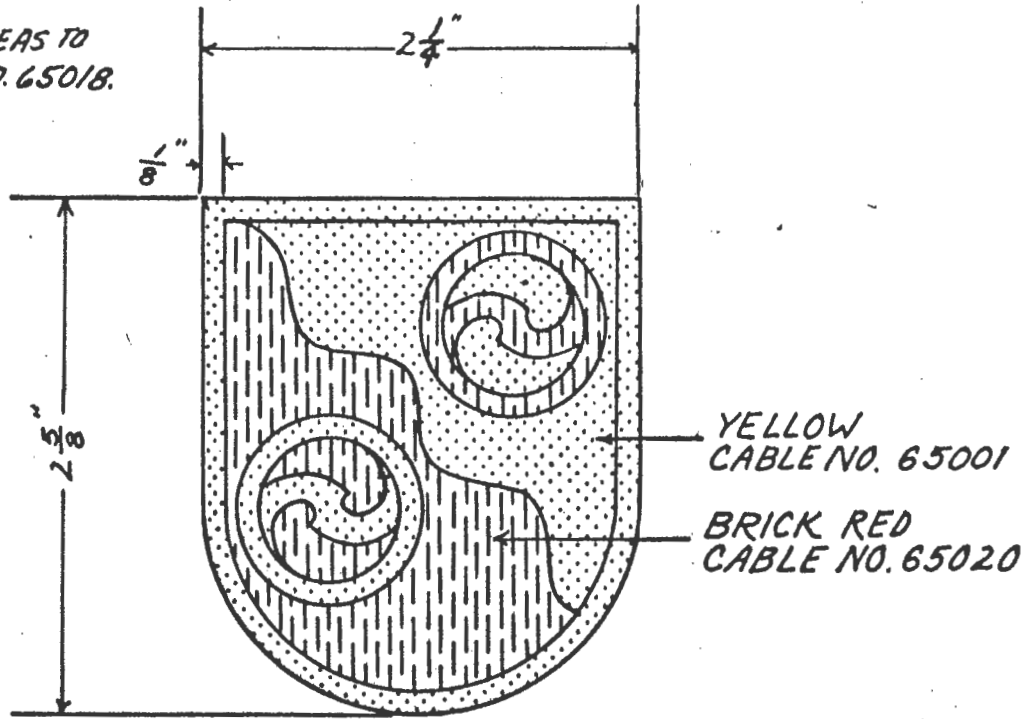
