SUBJECT: Heraldic Items for the 111th Sustainment Brigade, New Mexico Army
National Guard

1. As a result of the redesignation of the 111th Maneuver Enhancement Brigade to the 111th Sustainment Brigade, the distinctive unit insignia (DUI) and shoulder sleeve insignia (SSI) have been redesignated as outlined in enclosures 1 and 2.
2. Also enclosed are the following:
 - a. Manufacturing drawing, black and white line drawing, color print and actual size print for the DUI (encls 3-6).
 - b. SSI manufacturing drawing (A-1-564) and color print (encls 7 and 8).
 - c. Manufacturing drawing, black and white line drawing, color print and actual size print of the Combat Service Identification Badge (CSIB) (encls 9-12)
3. The Brigade flag will be divided vertically buff and scarlet with yellow fringe and the SSI centered. The U.S. Army Tank-Automotive and Armaments Command is responsible for the procurement of flags. To obtain your flag, complete DD Form 1348-6 on line at www.heraldry.army.mil; citing TIOH Drawing No. 5-1-310 and A-1-564, in the remarks section. SUBJECT: Distinctive Unit Insignia for the 111th Sustainment Brigade, New Mexico Army National Guard

1. The distinctive unit insignia (DUI) redesignated effective 1 September 2016, for the 111th Sustainment Brigade, was:

a. **Originally approved** for the 726th Antiaircraft Artillery Gun Battalion, New Mexico National Guard by letter MGRH 424.2 & 421.4, The Quartermaster General, 9 April 1953.

b. **Redesignated** for the HHB and Noncolor Bearing Units of the 111th Artillery Brigade, New Mexico Army National Guard by letter AGAH-A, The Institute of Heraldry, 30 October 1970.

c. **Redesignated** for the HHB and Noncolor Bearing Units of the 111th Air Defense Artillery Brigade, New Mexico Army National Guard by letter AGAH-A, The Institute of Heraldry, 9 February 1973.

d. **Amended** to revise the description by letter TAPC-PDH-Z, The Institute of Heraldry, 21 December 1998.

e. **Redesignated** effective 1 February 2008, for the 111th Maneuver Enhancement Brigade with the symbolism revised by letter AAHS-HIS, The Institute of Heraldry, 20 November 2008.

2. The description and symbolism of the design are as follows:

DESCRIPTION

A Gold color metal and enamel device 1 1/8 inches (2.86 cm) in height overall consisting of a shield blazoned: Or, an Avanyu Sable; a bordure gyronny of the first and Gules. Attached below the shield a Gold scroll inscribed "MIRAS ARRIBA" in Black letter.

SYMBOLISM

The shield of the coat of arms of the 200th Artillery differenced by the addition of a border, divided red and yellow for Artillery, is used to indicate the descent of the Brigade from that organization. The Avanyu is a figure representing happiness and prosperity, which was used by the ancient Pueblo Indians in New Mexico. The motto translates to "Keep Your Goal High."

3. This authorization is in accordance with AR 670-1 and National Guard Bureau Organizational Authority Number 58-16, dated 5 April 2016. A copy of this letter will become part of your permanent organizational history files.

SUBJECT: Shoulder Sleeve Insignia for the 111th Sustainment Brigade, New Mexico Army National Guard

1. The shoulder sleeve insignia redesignated effective 1 September 2016, for the 111th Sustainment Brigade with the description updated, was:

a. **Originally authorized** for the 111th Air Defense Artillery Brigade by letter DAAG-HDA, The Institute of Heraldry, 20 July 1973.

b. **Redesignated** effective 1 February 2008, for the 111th Maneuver Enhancement Intelligence Brigade with the description and symbolism updated by letter AAHS-IHS, The Institute of Heraldry, 20 November 2008.

2. The description and symbolism of the design are as follows:

DESCRIPTION

On a yellow shield, 3 inches (7.62 cm) in height and 2 inches (5.08 cm) in width overall arched at the top and bottom, in base a yellow demi-sun bordered scarlet, with seven scarlet rays two horizontal rays on each side and three vertical rays all the same length, with tops barbed all within a 1/8 inch (.32 cm) scarlet border.

SYMBOLISM

The modified ancient Indian sun symbol of Zia was suggested by the State Flag of New Mexico. The barbed sun rays allude to the Brigade's former mission to provide air defense for forward combat elements. The horizontal bars also symbolize defense and control, while the vertical bars allude to 111 further distinguishing the numerical designation of the Brigade. The colors red and yellow, the national colors of Spain, refer to the historical Spanish influence in New Mexico. Scarlet and yellow are the colors used for the Artillery, the previous designation of the unit.

3. This letter also serves to redesignate the Combat Service Identification Badge.

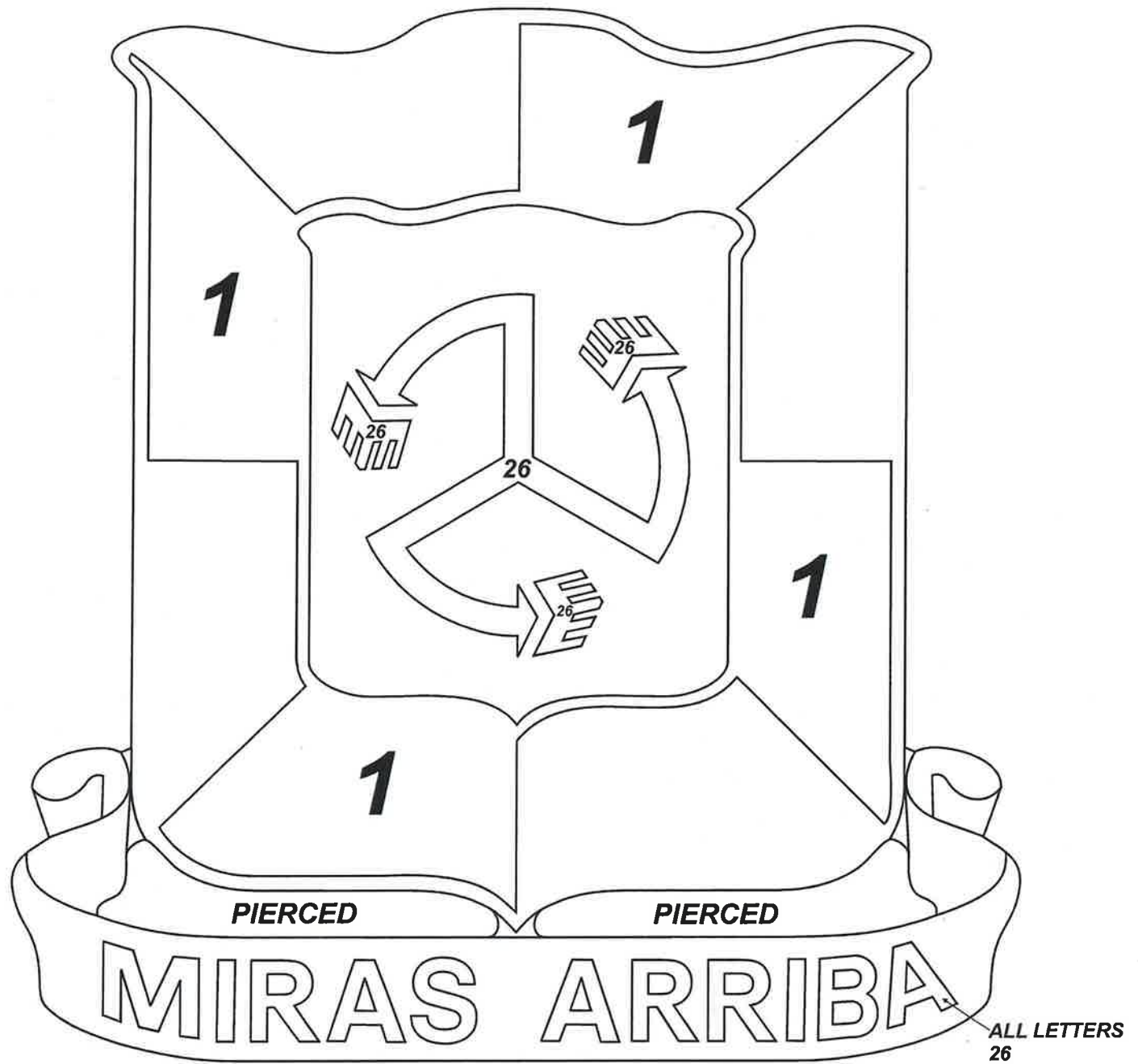
