SUBJECT: Heraldic Items for the 219th Engineer Brigade, Indiana Army National Guard

- 1. As a result of the redesignation of the 219th Battlefield Surveillance Brigade to the 219th Engineer Brigade, the distinctive unit insignia (DUI) and shoulder sleeve insignia (SSI) have been redesignated as outlined in enclosures 1 and 2.
- 2. Also enclosed are the following:
- a. Manufacturing drawing, black and white line drawing, and color print for the DUI (encls 3-5).
- b. SSI manufacturing drawing (A-1-959) and color print (with the subdued and line drawing) (encls 6 and 7).
- c. Manufacturing drawing, black and white line drawing, and color print of the Combat Service Identification Badge (CSIB) (encls 8-10)
- 3. The Brigade flag will be divided vertically scarlet and white with yellow fringe and the SSI centered as shown on enclosure 11. The U.S. Army Tank-Automotive and Armaments Command is responsible for the procurement of flags. To obtain your flag, complete DD Form 1348-6 on line at www.heraldry.army.mil; citing TIOH Drawing No. 5-1-310 and A-1-959, in the remarks section. SUBJECT: Distinctive Unit Insignia for the 219th Engineer Brigade, Indiana Army National Guard

- The distinctive unit insignia (DUI) redesignated effective 1 September 2016, for the 219th Engineer Brigade, was:
- a. **Originally authorized** for the 219th Support Group by letter JDRP-IH-HS, The Institute of Heraldry, 16 August 2005.
- b. Redesignated effective 1 September 2008, for the 219th Battlefield Surveillance Brigade and amended to revise the symbolism by letter AAHS-IHS, The Institute of Heraldry, 31 January 2008.
- 2. The description and symbolism of the design are as follows:

DESCRIPTION

A gold color metal and enamel device 1 1/8 inches (2.86 cm) in height consisting of a scarlet shield bearing the face of a snarling tiger detailed in black, scarlet, and gold brown. Enclosing the base of the device a black bipartite motto scroll doubled gold inscribed "EYE OF THE TIGER" in gold metal letters.

SYMBOLISM

The face of the tiger recalls the Group's motto, "Eye of the Tiger." The shield shape of the device symbolizes protection and defensive support. The colors, buff, here represented as gold, and scarlet, refer to Support branch colors, the original designation of the unit. Black denotes strength and solidarity and recalls the markings of the tiger. Gold also signifies honor and excellence.

SUBJECT: Shoulder Sleeve Insignia for the 219th Engineer Brigade, Indiana Army National Guard

- 1. The shoulder sleeve insignia redesignated effective 1 September 2016, for the 219th Engineer Brigade with the symbolism updated, was **originally authorized** for the 219th Battlefield Surveillance Brigade by letter AAHS-IHS, The Institute of Heraldry, 28 February 2008.
- 2. The description and symbolism of the design are as follows:

DESCRIPTION

On a vertically divided through the center arrowhead-shaped item, blue and red, displaying in the center a vertical black sword, edged yellow and pointed up, superimposed across the top by three yellow lightning bolts, diagonally from right to left, the middle lightning bolt surmounting the blade; all within a 1/8 inch (.32 cm) black border. Overall dimensions are 3 1/8 inches (7.94 cm) in height and 2 3/4 inches (6.99 cm) in width.

SYMBOLISM

The arrow-shaped insignia, adapted from the U.S. Recondo School, Recondo/Reconnaissance philosophy of highlights the developing the traits of smart, skilled, tough, courageous, and confident Soldiers. The divided background colors of blue and red signify the unit's lineage to the 38th Infantry Division. The black sword outlined in yellow emphasizes the stealth required for proper intelligence collection, indicating missions along the forward edge of the battlefield and the Brigade's readiness to sustain the tip of the battlefield. The lightning bolts symbolize the three tenants of the former Battlefield Surveillance responsibilities intelligence, surveillance. Brigade's of reconnaissance.

3. This letter also serves to redesignate the Combat Service Identification Badge.
